### **IMPORTANT - Letter from the Committee**

Recently the Club Committee held a Meeting.

Among the ordinary items for discussion around the upcoming show, the Committee met to discuss the upcoming AGM and election of Office Bearers and Committee. Election of Office Bearers and Committee members is done by formal ballot at the AGM. A number of the existing Club Committee have indicated they do not wish to stand again, at the next AGM and the Committee is concerned that unless people stand we will have no Committee or Office Bearers to carry forward as a viable club.

As per the Club Constitution: https://www.cavalierclubnsw.com/ethics-and-rules:

Part III – Item 24. There shall be a Committee consisting of the Office Bearers and eight members.

Part III – Item 73. The Office Bearers of the Club shall be: (a) the President for the time being of the Club who, unless otherwise determined by the members, shall not hold office for more than three (3) years in succession; (b) Two Vice-Presidents (c) The Treasurer (d) The Secretary

This letter is to notify members that people will need to nominate for these positions, including the Office Bearer roles as well as potential Committee positions. Unless these positions are filled at the AGM the Club may have to modify how it functions. It may be necessary to reduce Club activities to a minimum, or windup the Club.

The Committee felt it important to advise the Club of the following impacts should the Club no longer be viable and is to be wound up.

- The loss of a well-recognised and trusted Breed Club that has made the introduction of and contributions to the Cavalier breed in NSW and Australia. The history of which covers over a half century of promoting, showing the breed and educating the public. Our history is documented via the Yearbooks which have been donated to the Library of Dogs NSW.
- 2. The loss of participation in Club Championship Shows and point scores.
- 3. he loss of a successful Rescue Service that has been able to rescue and rehome many dogs, young and old; sickly and healthy over time.
- 4. The loss of the Website, Newsletter and Yearbook, catering to both the Club Members and the general Public.
- 5. The loss of Club organised gatherings such as the Fun and Information day and attendance at Dogs NSW Exhibitions and Open Days and other commercial exhibitions such as Sydney Dog Lovers Show.
- 6. The loss of Club organised Health Clinics to support Club members.
- 7. The loss of financial contributions to Health studies conducted by reputable organisations for the betterment of the breed.

The Committee discussed possible ways forward to alleviate the load on any future Committee. Members are encouraged to discuss these options and contribute ideas in other ways to keep the viability of the Club.



#### Options include the following:

Option 1: At the AGM, members nominate and stand to fill all positions – the Club continues as normal.

Option 2. The Club reduces its annual workload by limiting the number of shows and other activities.

Option 3. The Club eliminates all shows. This is drastic, but the Club is not required to run shows, under Dogs NSW regulations

Option 4. Running the Club as purely, a member and public information resource, by keeping the website and its content, as well as running the Rescue Service as its main financial entity.

Option 5. Positions needing to be filled are:

President

2 Vice President

Treasurer Secretary

8 Committee positions (present committee members may stand again)

Having said all that, the Committee is keen for the Club to continue, but we must have members nominate and stand, to fill positions in the Committee and as Office Bearers.

All positions within the Committee will be available. Some positions we can confirm will have existing members who wish to continue, if there are multiple nominations for a position, election will be via the Club's election process. Election of Office Bearers and Committee detailed in the https://www.cavalierclubnsw.com/ethics-and-rules, Part III - Items 40 – 51

The Club will run a specific agenda for the General Meeting directly after the AGM to discuss viability options pending the outcome of elections at the AGM. Any final decision made by the Club will be voted on at a General Meeting and will be based upon all members inputs and if the worst case does arise, any process that involves the case of winding up the Club will be governed by the relevant Regulations and Acts that the Club is bound to.

Critiques CKCS Club of NSW Inc.

Thank you to the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of NSW for the invitation to judge the 97th Championship Show.

April 4, 2021

Judge - Rosemary Duffy (Caperway)

#### Baby Puppy Dog – 5 entered 4 shown

1st Tricolour – Caught my eye as soon as he entered the ring. A balanced baby of good shape. Pretty head with large dark eye, high set ears. Well angulated front and rear with short coupling all of which allowed him to move correctly. BABY IN SHOW

2nd Blenheim – Another of good breed type. Balanced head with high set ears. Would prefer a larger eye but still showed a soft expression. Well balanced with a good tail set. Moved well

3rd Blenheim - Another promising puppy with dark eyes and correctly set ears. Just slightly longer cast than 2 above but moved well

4th Blenheim – This puppy is at the awkward age. I would like to see a softer expression and prefer more spring of rib at this age. Good tail set. Coat is well broken up. A little unsure of himself on the move today.

#### Minor Puppy Dog – 2 entered and shown

1st Tricolour – Promising young pup of good breed type. Balanced head proportions with large dark eye and correct ear set. Lovely shape with correct angulation front and rear allowing him to move with reach and drive

2nd Blenheim – Another promising young pup of good breed type. Balanced skull to muzzle ratio with dark eye and high set ears. Would prefer a slighter longer upper arm. Moved a little close.

#### Puppy Dog – 1 enter 0 shown

#### Junior Dog – 5 entered and shown

1st Blenheim – Excellent breed type. Well presented and broken up coat. This young boy shows much promise. Balanced head with large dark eye and correctly set ears framed the head giving the softest expression. Correct neck into shoulder, well sprung ribs and carried a level topline at all times. Correct shape and balance. Moved true

2nd Tricolour – Good type with a well broken up coat. Good shape and correct tail set. Just a little upright in shoulder which spoilt a pretty picture. Moved well



3rd Blenheim – Good size and shape and well coated. Would prefer slightly more muzzle for skull. Dark eye and well set ears. Sufficient spring of rib and short coupled. Moved well but a little proud of his tail today.

4th Black & Tan – Pretty head with good eye and ear set. Just lacking in condition today which affected his stance and movement.

5th Blenheim – A lighter boned dog than those above. A little straight in shoulder but short coupled. Unsure of himself on the move today.

#### Intermediate – 5 entered 4 shown

1st Blenheim – Excellent breed type. Balanced head with soft expression, large dark eye and correct ear set. Well laid shoulder, Well sprung rib and short coupling. Moved well when he finally cooperated with his handler.

2nd Ruby – Slightly longer cast than one ahead. Sweet expression with dark eye and well set ears. Well laid shoulders, sufficient spring of rib. Moved strongly.

3rd Blenheim – Good type with balanced skull to muzzle ratio. Large dark eye. A little upright in shoulder and standing wide in front spoilt the picture. Very well coated and broken up.

4th Blenheim – This boy lacked the balance in head I was looking for. Correct front but would prefer more bone overall. Lacking in rear angulation which affected his gait. Coat was a lovely rich chestnut colour.

#### Limit Dog – 5 entered and shown

1st Ruby – Excellent breed type. Well balanced throughout. Well balanced head with sweet expression, dark eye and correct ear set. Well laid shoulder and short coupled with good set of tail. Well coated and beautifully presented. Moved with confidence ..... RE-SERVE CHALLENGE DOG

2nd Blenheim – Another of good breed type with balanced head giving sweet expression. Well angled front and rear allowed him to move strongly. Just a little proud of his tail today.

3rd Blenheim – Good type with a stronger head than two above. Good shape on the stack. Lacked condition which resulted in loose elbows giving the appearance of a wide front coming towards me.

4th Blenheim – Good type with well balanced head, dark eye and correct ear set. Just a little upright in shoulder and would prefer a little more angulation behind. Well coated and presented.

5th Tricolour – This boy was not happy today. Good strong head, dark eye and correct ear set. Good shape on the stack but would prefer stronger drive from the rear.



#### State Bred Dog – 5 entered 4 shown

1st Tricolour – Good breed type. Balanced head, dark eye and correct ear set. Well angulated front and rear allowed him to move true. Well broken up coat.

2nd Blenheim - Good breed type. Well balance head with sweet expression. Good well broken up coat. Just not moving true going away.

3rd Blenheim - This boy was just a little longer cast than two above, Sweet expression. I would prefer a little more leg under him for balance. Moved true.

4th Blenheim – Smaller built boy. I would prefer more bone. Moved true in front but lacked rear drive.

#### Australian Bred Dog – 4 entered and shown

1st Black & Tan – Excellent breed type. Balanced head, well set ears and dark eye. Sufficient neck into well laid shoulders. Would prefer just slightly less through the loin but a quality dog. Excellent coat. Moved true coming and going.

2nd Ruby – Good breed type. A well balanced dog with good angulation front and rear. Carried his topline at all times. Moved true.

3rd Blenheim – Good type but not happy in the ring today. Balanced head with good eye and well set ears. Topline appeared a little soft but as he was not cooperating with his handler, it was difficult to assess.

4th Blenheim – Another of good type with well set ears and dark eye. A little up in shoulder spoilt the overall balance of this boy and he was a little wide in front coming towards me. He was well coated and beautifully presented. Would prefer more reach and drive on the move.

#### Open Dog 5 entered and shown. A strong class which was a pleasure to judge

1st Blenheim – Excellent breed type. Soft expression, balanced head with large dark eye and well set ears. Good neck into well laid shoulders. Front and rear angulation balanced. Carried his topline at all times and tail came off his back correctly. Good coat well broken up. Moved with verve.

Happy to award him ..... DOG CHALLENGE AND BEST IN SHOW

2nd Blenheim – Another of excellent breed type. Balanced head with soft expression. Good eye and well set ears. Well sprung ribs and short coupled. Carried a level topline and correct tail set. Moved true.

3rd Blenheim – Good type but a stronger head than two above. Large dark eye and well set ears framed his head. He was balanced throughout. Would prefer a little more condition him to tighten up. Well coated and well presented. Moved happily



4th Ruby – Good type with sweet expression. Dark eye and well set ears. Slightly longer cast than those above. Another who I would like to see with more condition on him as topline was a little soft and he lacked the reach and drive I was looking for.

5th Blenheim – Beautifully presented boy but well up in size. Strong head but balanced. Good bone. Level topline and correct tail set. Moved very quickly but soundly.

#### Baby Puppy Bitch – 5 entered and shown

- 1st Tricolour Well put together baby with a sweet expression, balanced head. Well made throughout with good lay of shoulder and well sprung ribs. Moved confidently
- 2nd Blenheim Another lovely baby with sweet expression, balanced head. Good front and rear angulation and correct tail set. Moved true but not as confidently as one above.
- 3rd Ruby Balanced young girl with sweet expression, slightly lighter in frame than two above. Dark eye and well set ears. Balanced angulation front and rear. Moved true
- 4th Tricolour Heavily marked young girl. Balanced skull to muzzle but would prefer a larger eye. Moderate angulation and still to develop sufficient spring of rib. Enjoyed her day out which showed on the move.
- 5th Blenheim Finer in bone pup but well broken up coat. Not sure of herself on the move

#### Minor Puppy Bitch – 6 entered 4 shown

- 1st Tricolour Promising young puppy. Balanced head with good skull to muzzle ratio. Large dark eye and well set ears. Neck into well laid shoulders, sufficient spring of rib and short loin. Good coat for age. Moved true
- 2nd Ruby Good type with sweet expression. Balanced head with well set ears. Balanced angulation front and rear. Moved well
- 3rd Tricolour Slightly longer cast puppy. Sweet expression with dark eye and well set ears. Sufficient spring of rib and balanced angulation front and rear. Moved well
- 4th ?? Would prefer more substance in this puppy for age. Head a little dry and lacked fill. Unsure of herself on the move today.

#### Puppy Bitch – 4 entered 3 shown

- 1st Blenheim Good breed type. Balanced puppy with sweet expression. Correct neck into well laid shoulders. Good spring of rib and short loin. Balanced angulation front and rear. Moved well
- 2nd Tricolour Pretty puppy with sweet expression. Good dark eye and correct ear set. A little short in upper arm which spoilt the overall balance. Lacked sufficient rear drive.



3rd ?? - Sweet expression with large dark eye and well set ears. A little finer in bone and frame than two above. Not happy to be in the ring today.

#### Junior Bitch - 7 entered 5 shown

1st Blenheim – Excellent breed type. Soft expression with dark eyes and high set ears. Correct neck into well laid shoulders, good spring of rib and short loin. Balanced angulation front and rear. Moved true and confidently

2nd Tricolour – Good breed type. Slightly stronger head than one above but dark eyes and correct set of ears which framed the face. A balanced girl throughout and shown in top condition. Perhaps a little too keen on the move

3rd Blenheim – Smaller girl who was balanced front and rear. Would prefer a larger eye. Well broken up coat. Moved well

4th Blenheim – Balanced head but would prefer better placement of eyes to soften the expression. Moderate angulation front and rear. Topline a little soft on the move but she was unsure of herself going around today.

5th Blenheim – Lighter built girl. Would prefer better balance of skull to muzzle. She was a little upright in shoulder which affected her movement

#### Intermediate Bitch – 6 entered 5 shown

1st Blenheim – Excellent breed type. Soft expression with large dark eye and well set ears. Well made throughout with balanced angulation. Level topline and correct tail set. Well broken up chestnut coat. Moved true and confidently ..... RESERVE CHALLENGE BITCH

2nd Black & Tan – Well presented, pretty girl with soft expression. Dark eyes and well set ears. Balanced angulation front and rear and carried a level topline with correct tail set. Moved well

3rd Blenheim – Happy girl with dark eyes and well set ears but would prefer a little more width of skull to muzzle. Although smaller built was balanced. Moving a little close behind today.

4th Blenheim – Prefer more bone throughout for this girl. She was unsettled in the ring and on the table. Well broken up marking.

5th Blenheim – Compact girl who showed a soft expression. Good spring of rib and short loin. Was not happy out today and showed it on the move with a soft topline and close behind.

#### Limit Bitch - 8 entered 6 shown

1st Blenheim – Good Breed Type. Balanced head skull to muzzle but prefer larger eye.



Good ear set. Well angled front and rear. Good neck into should with well sprung ribs. A well broken up silky coat and true movement finished the picture.

2nd Tricolour – Good Type. Soft expression with well set ears and large dark eye. Well laid shoulders and sufficient spring of rib. Unfortunately her topline was a little soft on the move.

3rd Tricolour – Lighter framed girl. Sweet expression. Balanced throughout and good angulation. Moved true

4th Black and Tan – Well presented young lady. Head just a little small for me but balanced skull to muzzle. She carried a good topline with correct tail set but a little loose in elbow and close behind.

5th Blenheim – Another well presented girl but lacking the balance in head I look for. Good spring of rib. Well broken up coat of good colour. Moving a little close coming and going today.

#### State Bred – 6 entered 3 shown

1st Blenheim – Good Breed Type. Very pretty girl with the sweetest expression. Good dark eye and correct ear set. A balanced girl with correct shape. Carried a level toptime. Well presented and moved true coming and going.

2nd Ruby – Good type. Balanced head but prefer larger eye. Good neck into shoulder placement. Sufficient angulation but not driving strongly behind on the move.

3rd Blenheim – Smaller built girl who lacked sufficient forechest. Carried a soft topline and moved a little close behind. Well presented silky coat

#### Australian Bred – 6 entered and shown

1st Black and Tan – Excellent Breed Type. Balanced head with the sweetest expression. Overall shape I look for, balanced with correct angulation. Carried a level topline at all times. Moved soundly

2nd Ruby – Very pretty girl with sweet expression. Well angulated front and rear and carried her level topline standing and on the move. Moved true and soundly

3rd Blenheim – Smaller type overall. Would prefer a little more muzzle to give the balance in head I look for. Good neck into shoulder but a little soft in the topline on the move. Well presented

4th Ruby – Beautifully presented girl but a little longer cast than those above. Balanced head but prefer a larger eye. She is a bit forward placed in front which spoilt her outline. Moved well

5th Blenheim – Well presented but would like a softer expression on this girl. Good neck into shoulders but a little soft in the topline on the move. Lacked a little in bone. Moved well



#### Open Bitch – 3 entered and shown

1st Blenheim – Excellent Breed Type. Well presented girl with well balanced head, large dark eye and well set and feathered ears. She presented the correct shape with excellent balance of front and rear angulation. Carried her topline at all times. Moved strongly behind with good reach in front. Happy to award her ..... BITCH CHALLENGE AND RUNNER UP BEST IN SHOW

2nd Black and Tan – A lot to like about this girl. Sweet expression, dark eye and well set and feathered ears. Good neck into well laid shoulders, level topline and correct tail set. Moved well. Would just prefer a little less coat but excellent black colour and tan pips.

3rd Ruby – A smaller girl but balanced head with sweet expression, dark eye and well set ears. A little straight in shoulder spoilt the overall shape. Moved with sufficient reach and drive.
