

I was looking for a small compact toy spaniel, with that typical soft gentle expression. I think I found that in a lot of my winners. My observations were size was quite uniform, not too many oversized exhibits. Mouths were good and teeth on the whole clean. Eyes were generally dark and pigmentation good. I thought there was more depth in the bitches today and in some hotly contested classes could have done with a few extra ribbons.

Baby Puppy Dog (6)

1st Munro Chevalove Casino Royale.

Very pleasing puppy. Handsome head of lovely type. Moderate skull with well set eyes, nicely cushioned muzzle and neat lip line, giving him that soft expression. Body was correct for his size and in good coat for one so young. Ample neck and good topline. Excellent temperament, very outgoing. Moved out well. Baby Puppy in Show.

2nd Blamire Elvenhome Luv Comes Calling.

3 Month blen', the baby of this class, developing very nicely. Pleasing head with lovely large dark eyes and good pigmentation. Compact well marked body, moderate bone and good topline. A happy little shower.

3rd Gilroy Dougsba Clam Chowder.

Neat little tri, with the most delightful expression. Nicely proportioned head with large dark eyes and rich tan face markings. Small cobby body and good reach of neck. First show a little nervous, and needs to gain a bit of confidence.

4th Humphries Lookingglass Zest For Life.

4 Month Blen' with a sweet head, larger in size than first three. Well-developed body, good topline and tailset. Moved well.

5th Donahue Cavalierlove To Be Boss.

Nice head, loved her gorgeous dark eyes and pigment. Chunky body developing nicely. Lovely temperament, showed well

Baby Puppy Bitch (10)

1st Peterson Dapsen Glitter In Champagne.

Very smart looking Blen' just coming up 5 months. Pretty head, with the darkest of eyes and good pigmentation. Flat skull, good earset gave her that lovely gentle expression. Compact body, balanced on the move. Just a lack of animation.

2nd Montford Elvenholme Luvinnia.

4 month Blen' smaller in size than 1. Pretty head round eye, good pigment giving her a pleasing expression. Ample neck, body developing nicely. Lovely rich chestnut markings. Moved and showed well.

3rd Humphries Lookingglass Zillion Kisses.

Liked the body on this one. Cobby , well sprung ribs. Good angulation. Presented a nice profile. Moved with confidence. Head should develop with age.

4th Humphries Lookingglass Young At Heart.

Well marked Blen' coming up 6 month, well developed body. Nice neck, level topline, well angulated rear.

5th Darwen Edenridge Cool N Classy.

Very nice profile on this B&T. Nice head Level topline, good reach of neck. Straight coat in good condition, lovely colour, rich tan. Needs to tighten up on move.

Minor Puppy Dog. (5)

1st Morse&Henderson Matmor Thriller.

Smart looking B&T with plenty of attitude. Broad skull , lovely well set ears which he uses really well. Dark round eyes well spaced , just enough muzzle. Good reach of neck set on a level topline. Firm body, good bone. Moved with plenty of drive. Showed really well.

2nd Munro Chevalove Richie McCaw.

Tri, of correct size and good shape. Head needs to develop Lovely reach of neck, well laid shoulders and a level topline. Good extension front and back on the move. Needs to body up a little. Coat in good condition, big white collar really shows off his neck.

3rd Wynn Jennawyn Spring Sunshine.

Well marked Blen' larger than first two. Nice head proportions, but would have preferred a rounder eye, which would have improved his expression. Body well developed. Short coupled, good depth of chest and moderate bone. Level topline and correct tailset. Moved OK.

Puppy Dog. (3)

1st Wright Belljari Chasing The Sun.

This glamorous Ruby boy ticked a lot of boxes for me. Fabulous head. Broad skull, good ear set. Large dark eyes with dark rims. Well cushioned muzzle and dense pigment gave him a lovely soft expression. Elegant neck and

shoulders, firm body and level topline. Moved out in style, well balanced, and covering the ground with ease. Showed really well. One to watch!

2nd Hennessy&Nade Ceellen Toy Boy.

Nice head and expression. Short coupled Blen' of correct size. Good lay of shoulder, giving him a nice straight front. Today, felt he didn't show himself to his best advantage

3rd Noakes&Perkiss Breshaad Got The Notion.

Masculine headed Blen' with dark eye. Up to size. Deep rich chestnut colouring. Solid body with good topline and tailset.

Junior Dog. (7)

1st Clift CH Brendamay Headless Gunner.

Smart looking Blen' Nice head proportions, not overdone in anyway. Round eye good pigment and nice cushioned muzzle give him a very appealing expression. Well put together body of good size. Lovely free moving action, with plenty of spring in his step. Looked nice in profile. Very alert, showed well.

2nd Madigan&Hennessy Ceellen Blackberry.

Well bodied Tri' in good coat. Well balanced head. Flat skull, well set ears. Dark eyes and well tapered muzzle. Long feathered ears framed his head nicely. Body firm, well sprung ribs and short coupled. Coat well marked, long, silky and of good texture.

3rd Morse&Henderson Matmor Dom Perignon.

Masculine headed B&T. Broad skull and large eyes. Just a little overdone for me. Exellent neck and shoulders set on a level topline. Shown in super condition. Coat long and silky and of good texture. Not an easy dog to show, tends to pull hard. Moves well when settled.

4th Mc Innes Innesveil Classic Lover.

Small nicely marked Blen'. Nice straight front and lovely lay of shoulder. Neat topline. Good tailset and carriage. Good earset, dark eyes. I think a neater lip line would have given his head a better balance.

5th Montford Elvenhome Love Me Do.

Nicely shaped Blen' only 11 months. Nice head framed with profusely feathered ears. Good pigmentation. Well sprung ribs, good shoulders and a level topline.

Intermediate Dog (5)

1st Petersen CH Dapsen Destruction Man.

Quality Tri'. Beautifully presented in full coat. Well broken markings with the addition of rich tan markings showing through, which gives him a striking appearance. Head well proportioned. Dark eyes, good length of muzzle with rich tan face markings, framed with well-set ears. Good firm body, level topline and well angulated rear. Well balanced on the move. I was pleased to award him Reserve Challenge Dog.

2nd Sanderson&Oliver Jezzamont Micaelangelo.

Well coated B&T in good condition. Fabulous large dark eyes. A little heavy in the head for me. Well sprung ribs, deep chest and good bone. Level topline and tailset. Needed more animation.

Limit Dog (5)

1st Munro Chevalove Keeper Of The Keys.

Liked the expression on this Blen'. Nice type. Good ear set, very appealing eyes, round, well-spaced. Well filled below the eyes and neat muzzle. Ideal shape and size. Well broken markings. Lovely temperament. Moved and showed well.

2nd Connell Portcon Back On Line.

Well marked Tri' in good coat. Nice short compact body. Ample neck, good shoulders. Showed well.

3rd Axiak Kaliak Kraker Jack.

Blen' with deep chestnut markings. Excellent reach of neck and good level topline. Larger and longer in body than first two. Not the easiest dog to handle.

4th Potter Blakesleigh Peace Haven.

Well marked Blen' Level topline and tail set. Think he had his mind on other things today, was a real handful.

Australian Bred Dog. (11)

1st Archer CH Lookingglass Quartermaster.

I was first drawn to this dog by his expression. Broad skull well set eyes, large dark and round. Well filled below the eyes and a nicely tapered muzzle. Overall a nice balanced head. A little up to size for me, but on closer inspection a well-balanced body. No lack of substance. Chunky body and good angulation. Moved with style and showed really well.

2nd Petersen CH Dapsen Im Sexy And I Know It.

Blen', well presented and in good coat. Perfect for size and shape. Across the ring he attracts your attention with a clean cut profile. Well balanced on the move holding a level topline. His head didn't have the appeal of 1.

3rd Montford CH Elvenhome Brios Legacy.

Liked the overall conformation on this Blen' Masculine head, broad flat skull with good ear set and nicely cushioned muzzle. Slightly arched neck and well laid shoulders. Short coupled and well angulated rear. Very alert little dog and shows really well.

4th Donahue&Boyce CH Cavalierlove Pollys Pride.

Richly marked Blen' Pleasing head with dark eyes and good pigment. Nice size, short cobby body with a level topline. Enjoys his showing.

5th McInnes CH Innesveil Classic Romance.

Small compact little Blen' Typy head with dark eyes and a black nose. A fluent mover. Holds a good topline. A little out of sorts today.

Open Dog. (9)

1st Egan&Weekes CH Melloway Adrenaline Rush.

I've picked three words out from my notes which go a long way to summing up the qualities of this dog. Stunning, Showman, Toy Spaniel. He is a Blen' that fills your eye and was a deserving winner at the end of the day. Perfect for size and presents a lovely profile. Handsome head large dark round eyes, good pigment, well cushioned muzzle giving him that typical soft gentle expression. Moves true, well balanced and covers the ground with ease. Well coated and well presented. Must be a pleasure to show. Dog Challenge & BEST IN SHOW.

2nd Paul&Fox GR CH Leisureview Omar Sharif.

Quality Blen' a handsome dog with great appeal. Typical head with nice proportions. A combination of flat skull, large dark eyes and black nose gave him a lovely expression.
