The following provides details of the copy format that you must produce and provide to the Club to be added to the Club Yearbook for advertising. Diagram provided as sample reference.

Resolution: 300 DPI Minimum - 400 DPI Maximum.

Copy Size: To be provided to the Club A5, 148 x 210 mm + 5 mm bleed (see below)

Bleed: Allow 5 mm in your image for bleed in your copy for colour printing to edge

Margin: 10 mm. Put content in the SAFE area. Avoid putting any important content in the margin to allow for ring binding or other print/trimming adjustments

Colour: CMYK press ready. Note, colour variation may still occur with printing from your computer image

Format: jpg or pdf

Content: Keep your content clear and concise and avoid cluttering of text and photos. Ensure your text is legible and only 2 photos per page.

Baby puppy dog

1. MATMOR RYTHM IS MY BUSINESS

Black and tan with lovely proportions, very promising. Well angulated, good croup, good body. Moves with confidence. Well shaped head with lovely expression. Excellent temperament, full of confidence.

2. ELVENHOME FINNIAN

Very classical blenheim. Head with promising, correct proportions but that needs more time to develop. Well built with good body and angulations. Moves with confidence and really good reach on a loose lead. Excellent temperament.



3. SHAMRAMI MOON OVER MONTANA

Just a baby, 3 months old, lovely marked blenheim with spot. Lovely confidence, that shows when he moves. Good angulations. Charming temperament.

4. CAVALIERLOVE RED HOT REBEL

Beautifully marked blenheim. Lovely colours. Head still needs to be flatter in skull. Good angulations. A bit steep in croup. Moves with really good reach. Lovely temperament.

5. CHARTREUSE LET ME ENTERTAIN U

Blenheim, nice head, beautiful eyes. Very good neck. Moves with good reach, but still a bit loose in topline. Lovely temperament.

Baby puppy bitch

1. ELVENHOME A FINE ROMANCE

Lovely, classical blenheim bitch, very promising. Well balanced with good angulations. Well marked, promising coat. Feminine head and expression, dark eyes. Moves with excellent reach and balance on a loose lead. Excellent temperament.

2. PABIANPARK POETRY IN MOTION

Really nice, feminine baby. Blenheim with rather good markings. Excellent ribcage and body for age. Nice head with lovely eyes. Moves well. Needs more confidence, sweet and friendly.

3. JEZZAMONT I GOT THE POWER

Sweet ruby girl with beautiful eyes. Well built with good angulations. Moves well. Very nice temperament.

4. KANDCCAMO MISTS OF AVALON

Sweet 3 months blenheim baby. Beautiful eyes. Moves well with happily wagging tail. Very nice temperament.

5. CEELLEN OPHELIA

Well marked blenheim girl. Beautiful eyes. Good angulations. Moves well when she decides she wants to! Lovely temperament.

Minor puppy dog

1. COOLORA DESIGNED BY TIME

Well balanced, well marked blenheim. Masculine, with good head and beautiful eyes. Moves happily, good reach in front, a bit short behind. Very nice temperament.

2. COLOORA HEZ OUR SECRET

Already fully grown and up to size, don't need to become heavier. Well marked blenheim. Nice head, dark eyes. Good angulations in front. Moves ok. Very nice temperament.

3. MISTYMILLS I HAD A DREAM

Heavily marked tricolor. Nice head with beautiful eyes. A bit short in ribcage and breastbone. Steep in croup, otherwise enough angulations. Needs to be stronger in movements. Very nice temperament.

Puppy dog

1. CAVALIERLOVE FULL ON ADDICT

Blenheim boy with quite good colour and markings. Well developed for age. Normal angulations but rather steep in croup. Happy mover with good reach. Very good coat quality. Lovely happy temperament.

2. CHEVALOVE NOBLE BY DESIGN

Classic blenheim boy with good coat, colour and markings. Should have stronger pigmentation. Moves well from side, but close behind. Sweet temperament.

3. ELVENHOME THANKS FOR THE MEMORY

Nice size and proportions. Well marked blenheim boy. Slightly short in ribcage and breastbone. Happy mover with good reach and tailcarriage, needs to be firmer coming and going. Sweet temperament.

4. ELVENHOME JUST ONE LOOK

Very masculine blenheim boy a bit up to size, slightly long in lines. Well built and very strong movements. A bit coarse in head. In between coats today. Nice and friendly temperament.

5. COLOORA RUMOURS FLY

Very nice size, but could be a bit more up on his legs. Sweet head and expression. Rather well marked tricolor. A bit short in ribcage. Happy mover, but still very loose coming and going, and needs a firmer topline. Nice temperament.

Junior dog

1. COLOORA CUTTING EDGE

Handsome, masculine blenheim with nice proportions. Beautiful classical head with lovely dark eyes. Nice spot. Normal angulations but a bit steep in croup. Moves well, could be slightly stronger in hind movements. Excellent coat and colour. Very nice temperament.

2. CHEVALOVE MAJESTIC TREASURE

Masculine blenheim boy with good proportions. Nicely shaped head with beautiful dark eyes. Ok coat quality. Good mover. Nice temperament.



3. ELCAVEL MAKE BELIEVE

Masculine, well broken blenheim. Nice head, slightly almondshaped eyes. A bit upright in shoulder and steep in croup, otherwise normal angulations. Very good coatquality. Nice movements. Very nice temperament.

4. CEELLEN ONE FOR THE ROAD

Well broken blenheim. Nice head, dark but a bit almondshaped eyes. Happy mover, with good reach in front, a bit short behind. Happy, outgoing temperament.

5. CABROOK IM A REBEL

Very nice size and proportions. Well marked blenheim. A bit broad and coarse in skull, and rather short nose. Beautiful dark eyes. Needs to be stronger in hindquarters, both standing and moving. Very nice temperament.

Intermediate dog

1. MERSEYPORT DIAMONDS FOR KEEPS

Sweet but still masculine, classical and well balanced. Very nice head and expression, well shaped dark eyes. Correct coat, well marked blenheim. Moves with excellent balance and lovely tailcarriage. Lovely happy temperament.

2. MATMOR A SCANDALOUS AFFAIR

Glamorous ruby with lovely colour. Slightly overcoated. Lovely head and expression, with dark well shaped eyes. Moves with good reach and drive but could use his tail better, to show off the typical temperament. Nice and friendly.

3. KANDCCAMO BAD LEROY BROWN

Classical blenheim with beautiful markings. Correct coat. Masculine and well balanced. Moves well, but sometimes a bit too proud over his tail. Nice temperament.

4. NABUCCO ROSSO

Strong and very masculine ruby. Beautiful coat and colour. Nice eyes, but a bit coarse in head. Happy mover. Nice temperament.

5. CHEVALOVE BLACK MAJIK

Masculine black and tan with lovely colours. Ok coatquality. Nice head with beautiful eyes. Needs to be stronger in movements, slooping topline. Nice and friendly.

Limit dog

1. BLAKESLEIGH SOHO DREAMS

Masculine, well balanced blenheim. Lightly marked. Not in best coat today, but nice fringes. Very nice head and expression, with beautiful eyes and well placed ears. Moves with lovely balance. Very nice temperament.

2. CEELLEN FIRE FLY

Solid, powerful blenheim boy well marked and with lovely dark colour. Beautiful well shaped and placed eyes. Moves with good reach. Very nice temperament.

3. CAPERWAY MEDIA CIRCUS

Blenheim with very good markings. Beautiful dark eyes, would prefer his cheeks to be less pronounced. A bit upright in shoulder. Happy mover. Very nice temperament.

4. CHEVALOVE MAJIK MOMENT

Tricolour, quite heavily marked. Very nice head and expression. Quite good coatquality. Moves happily with good reach. Very nice temperament.

5. DOUGSBA CLAM CHOWDER

Sweet tricolor with beautiful head and expression. Lovely eyes. Very nice size and proportions. Proud mover with good reach, but close from behind and turns elbows out. Slightly short in ribcage. Very nice temperament.

Australian bred dog

1. LOOKINGGLASS QUARTERMASTER

Attractive blenheim with lovely balance. Masculine with classic outlook. Very pleasing size and proportions. Very good colour and markings. Beautiful head with lovely expressive eyes. Moves with excellent balance and reach, strong topline, lovely tailcarriage, strong and confident. No exaggerations in any parts, just a solid, correct, classical cavalier! Nice and friendly temperament.

2. CAVALIERLOVE POLLYS PRIDE

Really nice blenheim with excellent coat and colour. Could be slightly better broken in markings. Beautiful head with well placed ears, beautifully feathered. Lovely eyes. Moves well from side, could be a bit stronger coming and going. Very nice temperament.

3. KALLIAK KRAKER JACK

Handsome blenheim with lovely shaped head. Dark eyes that could be bigger. Excellent coat and colour. Moves well from side, could be stronger coming and going. Very nice temperament.

4. MERSEYPORT BATTERSEA

Masculine, well balanced blenheim. Nice head and expression, with beautiful eyes. Moves with good reach, but could carry himself a bit better and be stronger coming and going. Very good colour and markings. Very nice temperament.

5. INNESVEIL CLASSIC LOVER



Masculine blenheim with beautiful markings. Very nice head and expression, beautiful eyes. Rather low set ears. A bit steep in croup. Moves well from side, could be stronger coming and going. Very nice temperament.

Open dog

1. MATMOR THRILLER

Glamorous black and tan with lovely size and proportions. Very good coat, colour and markings. Well shaped head with dark beautiful eyes. Normal angulations. Moves with pride, carries himself well, good reach. Very nice temperament.

2. DALVRECK MOONDUST

Handsome blenheim with good coat, colour and markings. Dark, a bit prominent eyes. Not in best condition on the day, a bit on the skinny side. Moves well from the side, close coming and going. Very nice temperament.

3. CHEVALOVE KEEPER OF THE KEYS

Solid, masculine blenheim, attractive markings with spot. Good coat. Good proportions. Very nice head with well set ears. Good side movements with lovely tailactivity, rather close from behind. Happy, friendly temperament.

4. BELJARI CHASING THE SUN

Ruby with many nice virtues, but unfortunately too high and rounded skull. Beautiful eyes. Excellent coat and colour. Moves with good reach but could be stronger coming and going. High tailcarriage. Very nice temperament.

5. BRESHAAD GOT THE NOTION

Solid blenheim with quite good head. Beautiful markings. Moves with good reach but close behind. Unfortunately doesn't enjoy his day and therefore lacks the enthusiasm we like to see in the breed. Nice and friendly.

Minor puppy bitch

1. KALIAK MATERIAL GIRL

Promising, well balanced, very feminine puppy. Well marked blenheim with promising coat. Beautiful head and expression, lovely dark eyes. Moves easy and happily on a loose lead, very good tailcarriage. Very nice temperament.

2. MERSEYPORT TINONEE

Very feminine, well marked blenheim with promising coat. Lovely head and expression, beautiful eyes. Normal angulations but steep croup. Moves with nice reach but needs to be stronger coming and going. Sweet temperament.

3. KANDCCAMO GOOD NEWS STORY

Beautiful feminine blenheim with very pleasing head and expression. Moves with good reach but needs to be stronger in topline and get more stability coming and going. Lovely use of her tail. Sweet temperament.

4. BARAKAH ETCHED IN GOLD

Nicely made ruby with excellent colour and coatquality. Beautiful head and expression. Lovely eyes. Bite needs to improve. Moves with good reach, but needs to be stronger coming and going. Very nice temperament.

5. INNESVEIL LOVE SPELL

6 months blenheim baby with very sweet head and expression. Lightly marked. A bit steep in croup, otherwise normal angulations. Moves happily but needs more stability both in movements and body. Very nice temperament.

Puppy bitch

1. COLOORA FIRE FLI

Feminine, well marked blenheim, with spot. Promising coat. Very nice head and expression, with beautiful dark eyes. Good body for age. Normal angulations, but steep in croup. Free, easy mover with lovely tailactivity. Excellent temperament.

2. CHEVALOVE CHANDON

Well bodied, well developed feminine blenheim. Very nice balance. A bit upright in shoulder. Very good ribcage. Free mover with good reach and tailactivity. Very nice temperament.

3. PABIANPARK IN FOR A PENNY

Another well marked, feminine blenheim. Well shaped head with beautiful eyes. Moves with good reach but needs to use her tail better and needs stronger topline. Very nice temperament.

4. CAVALIERLOVE SHOOTING STAR

Well marked blenheim with spot. Good coatquality. Very nice head, dark eyes that show some white. Steep in croup. Moves happily but needs more reach and strength behind. Very nice temperament.

5. EDENRIDGE SIMPLY IRRESTISTABLE

Very sweet black and tan. Lovely head and expression. Normal angulations but steep in croup. Moves with good reach but needs more stability all through. Charming temperament.

Junior bitch

1. KALIAK FEMME FATAL

Solid, but still feminine. Blenheim with very good coatquality, rather good markings. Beautiful head and expression, lovely head with excellent ears and eyes. Moves freely but a bit close behind. Very nice temperament.
